## Deck The Halls \& The Tree With Uh1!

Among our members there is at least one who has been brave enough to decorate their Christmas Tree with Uhl! Anna Mary Feldmeyer has trimmed her Christmas tree for several years with Uhl Christmas Jugs. The jugs were the only decoration used on the tree. She used thin cloth ribbons to hang the jugs. To satisfy her husband Don she had to knot the ribbon securely around the handle and knot the ribbon around the branch. When it came time to remove the jugs she had to cut the ribbons off. Her collection includes at least 2 of all of the Christmas Jugs she is aware of that were made by Uhl, even the rare 1943 piece with the paper label! This year, she decided to display the jugs on her kitchen window sills and won't be spending her time tying knots!


## Uhl Christmas Pottery

The holidays remind us of the Christmas pieces made by Uhl. A line of miniature Christmas jugs were produced with ink stamped greetings. Each year featured a different style jug. The ink stamp was used until 1943 when this piece was made with a special paper label that was applied to the miniature. In 1996 member and auctioneer Chip Kugler had an auction with one of these scarce pieces which sold for $\$ 1400$.

Even rarer to find, Kugler auctioned an Uhl Christmas pig bank in September 1996 for $\$ 4160$. Uhl made several sizes of pig banks, all are hard to find however this pig was completely unique, in mint condition and had a special message hand lettered on the bank "Merry Christmas '43 To: Mildred From: Gloria" Uhl.
This one of a kind pig was from the estate of Helen Utz. Helen's daughter was given the present at Christmas from a friend whose father worked at Uhl. Who wouldn't love to see a 1943 jug or this pig at the 2011 convention?!

## Louis Daum

Uhl history tells us in 1849 August Uhl and Henry Henn opened a pottery company. In 1851 Henn sold out to Louis Daum, who bought out August's stake in 1854. By that time August's younger brother, Louis, had joined him in Evansville, and in 1854 they founded A. \& L. Uhl Pottery Cio. In 1887 August sold out to Louis, and the pottery was renamed Louis Uhl \& Son.
Not many of us have Daum \& Son pieces of pottery or have even seen them, but Jim Marshall is lucky enough to own one. Jim's son, Scott is our commemorative potter at Yellow Banks Pottery in Selvin, IN. Scott noted Jim purchased the crock probably more than 20 years ago when an antique dealer who he had been purchasing pottery from showed him the piece. It is a 4 gallon crock marked "L. Daum \& Son" with a " 4 ". The piece would have originally had a lid. When Jim acquired the piece it was damaged but he was able to repair it. They would love to learn more about it. If you have more information, please contact a board member.

This fall at an auction on 6th Street in Ferdinand, Indiana there were some Uhl pieces. Two of the most notable were a $\# 7$ crock in excellent condition and a 1930 Christmas Jug. The \#7 crock sold for $\$ 1,250$. The Christmas Jug sold for $\$ 550$ and was apparently used by the owner of the estate for drafting purposes. He had it in the basement in his work area and used it as a guide for drawing circles! Sounds like a very valuable template!
