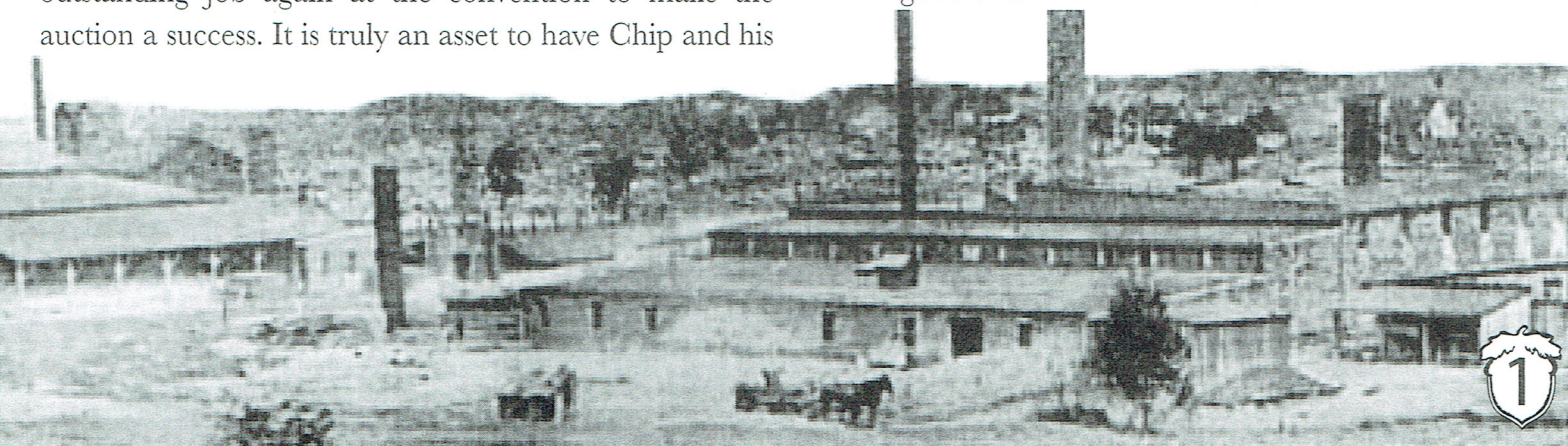
Happenings

There have been several good Uhl auctions in Dubois County recently and the Huntingburg Antique Show was August 21 and 22 with lots of members in attendance. It was a good one!

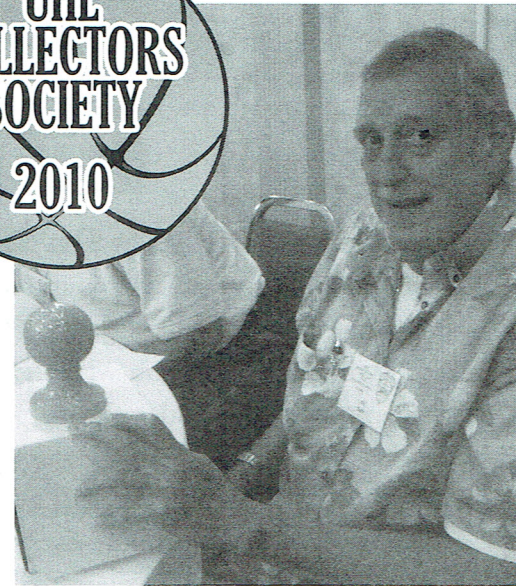


2010 Commemorative

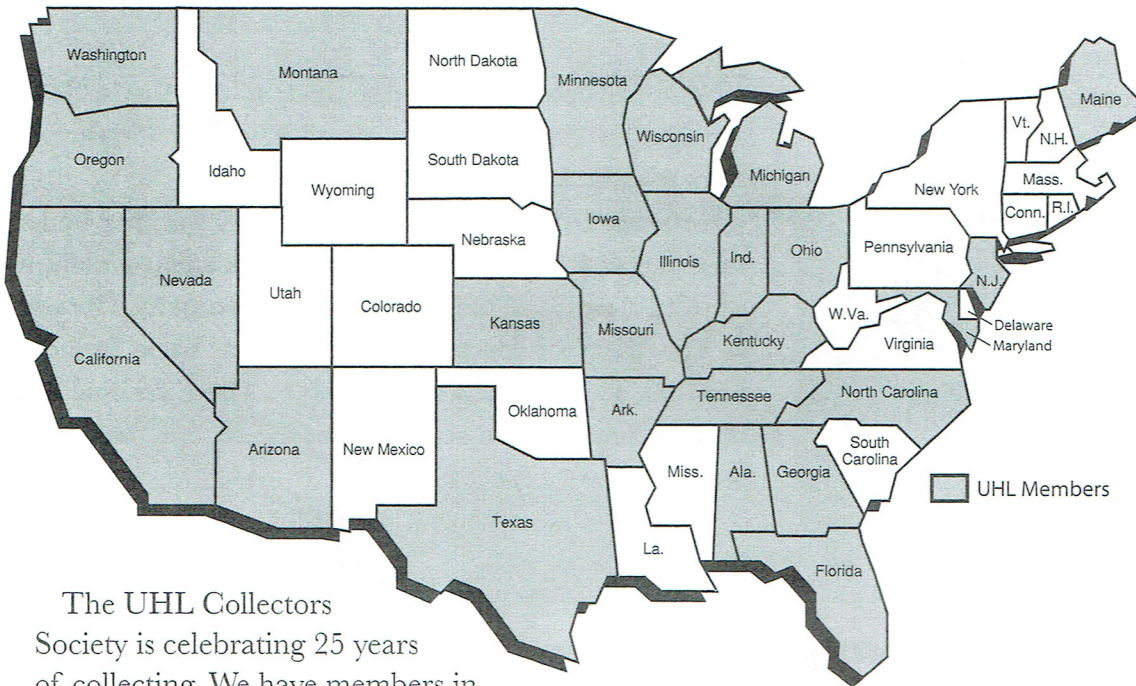
This year's convention auction included only 5 commemoratives, each in a truly one of a kind color. The 2011 auction will feature only 5 commemoratives as well to increase the value and rarity.

The rest of the story...

The basketball commemorative holds a special place in Uhl history and Huntingburg basketball history. The original piece was made as a small pottery trophy and was given to members of the Huntingburg High School basketball team who won the sectional in 1936 and 1938. It's been estimated that only 15 were made each year. The team was called the "Happy Hunters". At our 1996 convention auction one of these original Uhl basketballs brought \$2200!

I'm a collector and I know more than I should about UHL and lots of other things!

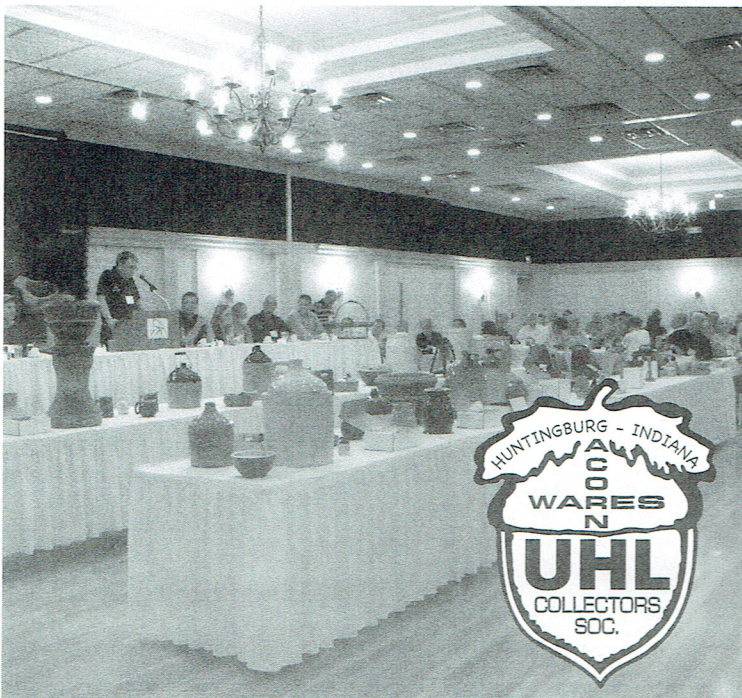
11-12 CORRECT ANSWERS

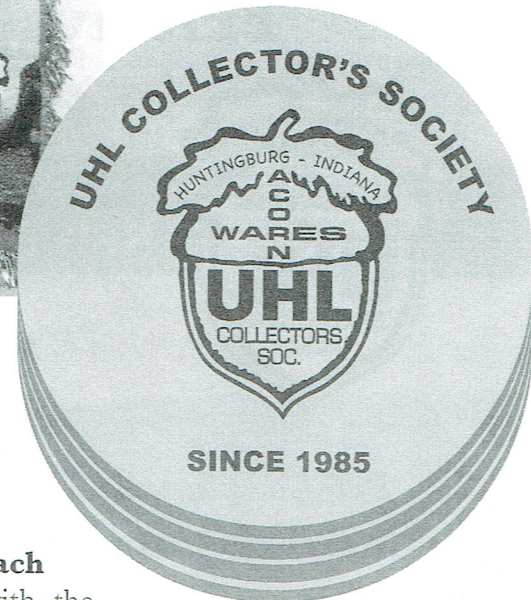
